

Current Report No. 19 /2026 Confirmation of credit ratings and outlook of Bank Ochrony Środowiska S.A. – published on 30 July 2026 at 14:35 pm

The Management Board of Bank Ochrony Środowiska S.A. of Warsaw announces that on 30 July 2026, the rating agency Fitch Ratings (the “Agency”) confirmed the Bank’s credit ratings and stable outlook.

The Bank’s ratings are as follows:

Long-Term Foreign Currency IDR: **‘BB-’, stable outlook,**

Short-Term Foreign Currency IDR: **‘B’,**

National Long-Term Rating: **‘BBB-(pol)’, stable outlook,**

National Short-Term Rating: **‘F3(pol)’,**

Viability Rating: **‘bb-’,**

Government Support Rating: **‘b’,**

Long-Term Deposit Rating: **‘BB’,**

Short-Term Deposit Rating: **‘B’.**

In its report, the Agency noted the Bank’s overall stable funding and liquidity position, moderate capital buffers, and strengthened yet below-peer profitability, alongside a higher risk appetite and weaker asset quality.
