- Popularization of pro-ecological behaviours, raising awareness and shaping attitudes among the employees of the Bank and BOŚ SA Capital Group;
- Popularization, among Customers, of the concept of environmental protection both by creating a pro-ecological banking offer and through promotional and marketing activities;
- Promoting sustainable development among business partners and companies cooperating with the Bank;
- Cooperation with institutions and organisations whose goals are aimed at environment protection and ecological education.
